



LL.B (Bachelor of Laws)



Bachelor of Business Administration-Bachelor of Legislative Laws is a five-year program that combines the knowledge of management with law. The programme offers practical training in law as well as a fundamental understanding of Management, Finance, Marketing, and Human Resources. The final semester offers regular interaction with management and litigation experts, Moot Court exercises, and internships.



The Bachelor of Arts LLB (Hons) is a comprehensive five-year programme that brings together the disciplines of humanities including Sociology, History, Political Science, Economics, Psychology, etc and a study of law. 


Eligibility and Selection Process
