



English



Liberal Arts


The BA in Liberal Arts programme at MIT-WPU is a three-year programme that combines subjects from the Humanities, Social Sciences, Performing Arts, Fine Arts, Media, Law, Management, Language, Computer Science, Music Therapy, Photography, and other integrated and interdisciplinary fields. The course's one-of-a-kind curriculum prepares students to acquire multiple skill sets as well as excellent problem-solving and communication skills. The programme's multidisciplinary approach includes 200+ subjects as part of core, co-curricular, general, and cluster electives. The programme is divided into eight semesters over three years and prepares students for successful careers in a variety of existing and emerging sectors.


